

### Message from Dexter King, Director, Strategic Procurement Services

The following table updates the new procurement thresholds for competitive purchasing. These changes took effect on January 1, 2024. Please be advised that the Provincial Government is currently updating its procurement guidance. When those details are finalized, Strategic Procurement will issue an additional bulletin informing the community of those changes.
