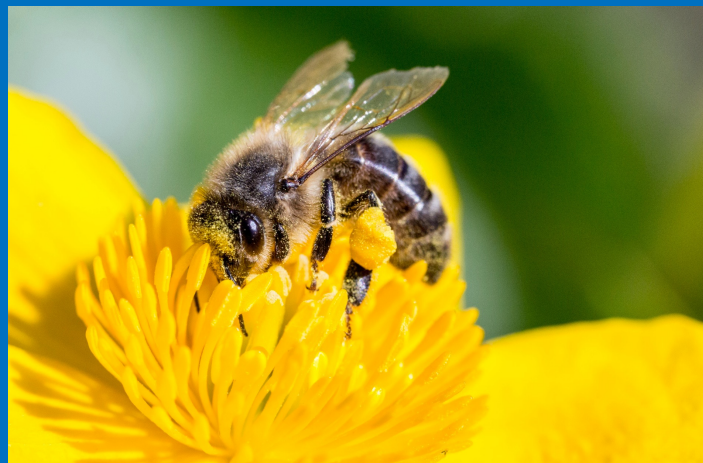

With the fall grant rush about to finish for some and for others in a month, have you started thinking about next year's Tri-Council grant rush? Whether you're new to Tri-Council applications, have not had recent success, or have plans on applying to a new Tri-Council grant, it's never too early to start planning a year ahead, for your CIHR, SSHRC, or NSERC operating grant applications.

In breakout rooms organized by Tri-Council, listen to faculty ADRs speak on how to set up, build, or strengthen your program of research, while previous winners of these operating grants explain how to edit and improve an unfunded grant and achieve funding the following year. Planning and writing a grant takes time - find out how much you can achieve in a year by working efficiently and strategically to craft a competitive application.
