READING STRATEGY



P REVIEW

Look for clues in the beginning of a reading to create a framework of meaning and get an overview before you start reading. Look at the: title, table of contents, bold and italics, diagrams and graphics



Q UESTION

From what you have observed in your preview, generate questions that you will answer as you read. Try going beyond fact questions into deeper levels of critical thinking



R EAD

Read **ACTIVELY** to answer the questions you have created. Take it one section at a time, highlighting or writing down key words and ideas.



R ECITE

Translate academic language into your own words. Summarize the main ideas out loud and make notes about what you have learned. Try explaining the content from memory.



R EVIEW

Learning takes time. Review your notes and reading regularly to help build both your memory and understanding.
