ITEM FOR ACTION:

1. Changes to the Bachelor of Health Studies degree program

The Atkinson Faculty Council recommends the following changes to the Bachelor of Health Studies degree program. The changes are applied to calendar copy and outlined in table format below.

Rationale:

These changes are principally concerned with core requirements for all these streams in the School of Health Policy and Management.

The program recognizes the importance of all students in the School of Health Policy and Management having a basic knowledge of health policy, health management, and Health Informatics. Therefore, every student takes an introductory 3.0 credit course in each of these three areas. Those majoring in a particular stream take a second 3.0 course in that area. A Health Policy major will take a required second course in Health Policy following the introductory course; a Health Management major will take a required second course in management; and an Informatics major will take a required second course in Informatics.

This revised proposal for modifications in degree requirements is also founded in the recognition of the strengths of faculty hired. This was unknown when the program was originally designed and consequently some of the areas of expertise of new faculty were not included in the original design. The program as now structured takes into account the expertise and research focus of the faculty. It also reflects discussions with people in the field of health policy, management and Informatics.
