

Disruption Resulting from CUPE 3903 Strike Has Ended Communication from the Executive Committee of Senate

19 April 2024

Members of CUPE 3903 Units 1, 2 and unit 3 have voted to ratify an agreement with the University and end their strike. As a result, the Executive Committee of Senate declares that the disruption of academic activities that began on 26 February 2024 **has ended**.

The Remediation Period begins on Monday, 22 April 2024.

Courses and related academic activities that were suspended as a result of the strike will resume during a formal remediation period for Y 2023-2024 and W 2024 courses. Dates for the remediation period are set out below.

Particularly important is the remediation framework document “Course Completion Options and Finalization of Grades”. First issued on 7 March 2024, the most recent version setting out options for students and faculty members is 19 April 2024, which is posted on the Senate [Labour Disruption](#) site.

Take note: The FW’23 and Winter term 2024 course completion options and related deadlines that have been authorized by the Committee during the disruption **remain in effect through to the end of the remediation period, on 26 May 2024**. For example, assessed grades, changes to the number, kind, and weight of assignments, and the pass / fail grades option continue to be available to students and instructors to facilitate the completion of courses.

Bear in mind too, that the principles of the Disruptions policy – *academic integrity, fairness to students and timely information* – together with specific guidance in the “Course Completion Options” document noted above also continue to apply until classes and examinations for the Y and W terms have ended on 26 May 2024.
